To tie a kite string, start by making the holes for the string to pass through. Turn the kite over so you can see the back side and pierce two holes diagonally opposite from each other at the intersection of the kite sticks. Thread the string through the top hole and then back through the hole below it ...

A kite needs more support than just two bars in a cross formation. It needs to have some sort of outline to make it structured. To do this I used string that passes through the notches around the perimeter of the kite. First I tied yet another clove hitch to the vertical bar down at the bottom.
